Buffalo Trace

90 proof, Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey

Outstanding aroma, kicked off by a spicy prickly. Satisfyingly deep, gentle vanilla with a sprig of mint. Waxy sweetness is checked by a big build up of vanilla-rich oak. Finish dries as the oak takes command, but rye offers extra depth and a layer of bitterness, as does a lingering licorice. Uncompromising and complex beyond belief.

Eagle Rare

10-Year-Old, 90 proof, Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey

Bright honey/topaz color. The early aromas include gentle grain, toasted honey-wheat bread and tobacco leaf. An oily, toasty beauty seduces the taste buds at palate entry with dry flavors of cereal grain and mild oak resin – the mid-palate include sweet and oily flavors of raisins, grapefruit, charred oak and candied almonds. The finish is long, corny sweet and moderately fiery.

Blanton's Single Barrel

93 proof, Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey

The nose is very deep and satisfying. The taste has a masterful start with powerful dry vanilla notes in perfect harmony with hints of honey amid the strong caramel. The long, creamy caramel holds the fort until some late soft peppers arrive to spice things up. The underlying dryness amid the spice and honey really makes for bourbon that should suit all tastes and one to keep the discerning whiskey drinker almost purring with delight.

Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey

George T. Stagg built the most dominant American distillery of the 19th century, during a time known as the Gilded Age of Bourbon. Uncut and unfiltered, this robust bourbon whiskey ages for nearly a decade and boasts the bold character reminiscent of the man himself. Rich, sweet, chocolate and brown sugar flavors mingle in perfect balance with the bold rye spiciness. The boundless finish lingers with hints of cherries, cloves and smokiness.

E.H. Taylor Single Barrel

100 proof, Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey

The aroma carries lightly toasted oak, with dried figs and butterscotch. One sip brings flavors of sweetness balanced with tobacco and dark spices. The finish is just long enough to prepare the palette for another sip. The bottle itself is a likeness to Colonel Taylor's original design used over a century ago.

Sazerac Rye

90 proof, Kentucky Straight Rye Whiskey

Light amber/burnt orange color. The nose includes sun dried peaches and spice with a hint of caramel and oak. Notes of rye grass, peaches, light caramel and a huge burst of cinnamon spice. Pleasantly warm in the mouth and throat without the alcohol burn. The finish is fruity and sweet at first with a dash of spice and caramel. A little oak wood at the end leaves a very clean palate.

Elmer T. Lee

90 proof, Single Barrel
Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey

Medium gold in color; the nose brings notes of butterscotch, clover, vanilla, and old leather. The big body bears a palate with an almost wine-like character that balances intense fruits, honey, and vanilla with a light spiciness that shows off the distiller's craft. The finish is long and warm.

12-Year-Old, 90 proof • The Original Wheated Bourbon

The deep bronze color beautifully reflects the light – perfect purity. Aromas of lanolin, almond oil, creamed corn and toasty oak/vanilla. A high-spirited, lusciously toasty bouquet that has top-notch Bourbon written all over it. Dry, complex and toasty palate entry. The mid-palate flavor profile is heavily wheated, oily, layered and moderately sweet. Long, oaky, and intensely grainy finish.

Pappy Van Winkle's

Family Reserve 20-Year-Old, 90.4 proof
Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey

The nose is intensely fruited but also bears a tantalizing citrus zest note. The body is huge and almost chewable, and the palate is tremendously buttery with some sherry notes, a dash of dried fruits and some rich, creamy vanilla. The finish is long and elegant.
